

Uniform

It has been two years since the school introduced the new style tracksuits, and we have allowed a long period of transition so that children could get the most wear possible out of their old tracksuits. Please note that from September 2017, all children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be required to wear the new school tracksuit for P.E. lessons.



Our 'beanie' hats are an optional item of uniform. They can be worn only when children return from swimming lessons with wet hair. Caps and berets are to be worn at all other times.


