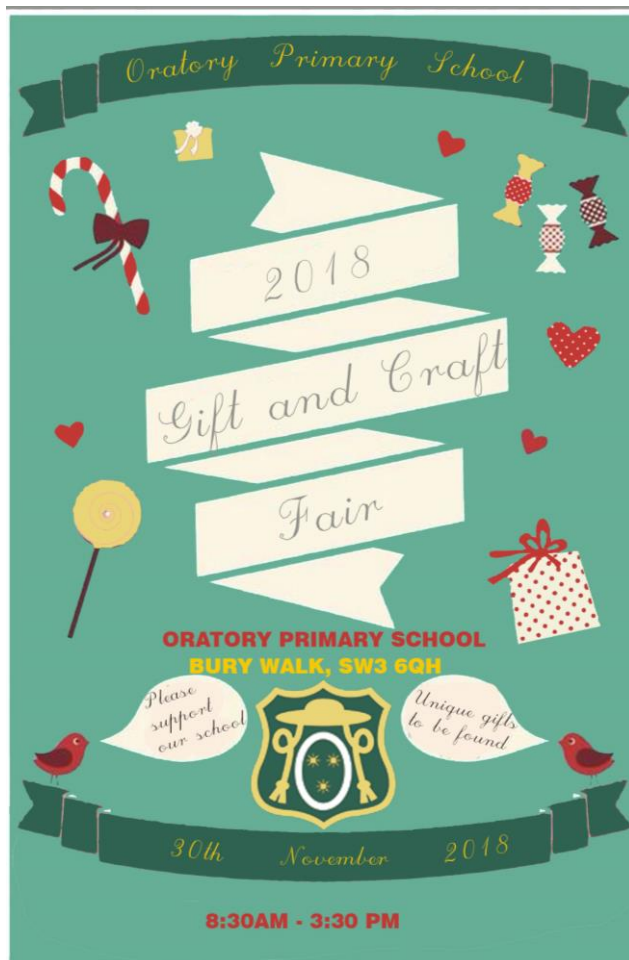


Parents' association News
