

Oratory Primary School Remote Learning Scenarios

| Scenario | Description of Remote Learning |
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| <p>Scenario 1: single child self-isolating</p> | <p>Teachers will send the day's work after school to parents. For example, Monday's learning will be sent via email to the parent on Monday evening for the child to complete on Tuesday. This is so that teachers can send annotated flipcharts to support the child.</p> <p>The teacher will email the introduction flip chart along with any tasks or instructions in PDF form.</p> <p>The email they send parents will contain the following generic paragraph:</p> <p><i>Child's absence while awaiting family Covid testing:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Thank you for informing us that you child is awaiting a Covid test. Please follow the guidance at the bottom of this email and alert the school when you have the result of the test.</i> • <i>This email contains the learning that your child's class completed today.</i> • <i>It may contain presentations, sheets to complete, or other learning activities.</i> • <i>If your child is feeling well, please encourage them to complete as much as they can. If they are unwell, they should rest and recuperate.</i> • <i>Your child can complete the work using any paper and writing implements they have at home.</i> • <i>If you cannot access the work due technology needs, please contact the headteacher.</i> • <i>We look forward to seeing your child at school as soon as it is safe for them to return.</i> <p>It is important to note that we do not expect the child to complete the work if they are unwell. This is only for children who have to stay at home when they are well enough to do the work. Likewise, parents will appreciate the fact that teachers are back to full class teaching and do not have the same amount of time that they did during lockdown to provide feedback and personal emails.</p> |
| <p>Scenario 2: Whole class self-isolating for two weeks. Teacher well and working from home.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Google Classroom will be the platform used to share home learning. • Teachers will create 5 short explanation videos which will be uploaded for children to watch before each task. • Teachers will upload videos, worksheets and slides to google classroom. • Some tasks should be completed online and others on paper. • Teachers will be able to see who has submitted work and will be able to feedback accordingly via google classroom. |

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| Scenario 3: Whole class self-isolating for two weeks. Teacher unwell and unable to work. | Pupils will follow learning from Oak National Academy for two weeks. |
| Scenario 4: Whole school in lockdown for longer period of time | Work completed in line with scenario 2. In addition, the school will provide fortnightly 'wellbeing check ins' over the telephone, in addition to google classroom feedback. |
