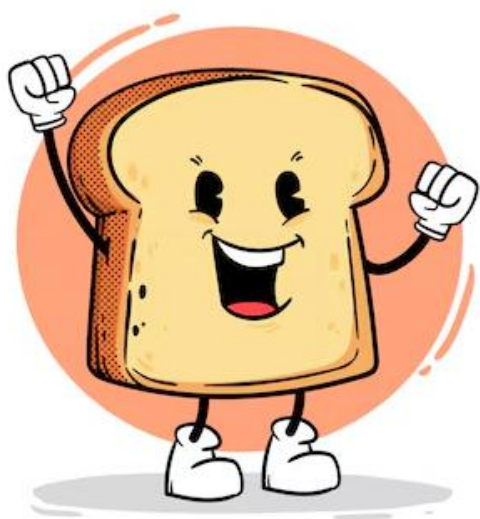


School Clubs Brochure Spring Term 2026

Please read this document in conjunction with the club timetable. Please follow the booking instructions carefully, and note the age range of the club before requesting a place for your child.



Welcome to the Oratory Breakfast club



Join us for a nutritious and fun start to the school day with our new Breakfast Club!

The children can participate in some calm activities with their friends (reading, board games, colouring) whilst enjoying a healthy breakfast ensuring they're set up for a great day.

Breakfast Club:

- You must book a place in advance by sending an email breakfast@oratory.rbkc.sch.uk. Payment must be made in advance on your ParentPay account to have a confirmed place. An email will follow to confirm your child's place.
- Booking can be made for a whole week / term or parents/carers can specify the exact days of the week required.
- You must arrive between 8:00 – 8.15 a.m. (no entry after 8.15 a.m.)
- Cost - £3.50 per day (sibling/s charged at £2.50 per day).

Breakfast Club will be held in the School Hall. Please enter through the main green door by the School Office.

Children will be offered a healthy breakfast such as, cereal, toast, fresh fruit and milk to ensure they have a great start to the day.

PianoFunClub

We believe that every child should have the opportunity to play music. We would like to offer your child the chance to learn a musical instrument during school hours.

Lessons are open to all children from Reception to Year 6. This club is fully booked at the moment with existing students however, please contact the provider to add your child to the waiting list.

Guitar, Piano or Violin - will be taught on a one-to-one basis by visiting professional tutors and all teaching materials will be provided. Each pupil will receive 10 lessons per term - lessons are booked in and paid for at the beginning of every new term and half term. The tutors will collect the child from their classroom and lessons will take place in our music room.

Instruments will be provided by Piano Fun Club (there will be an opportunity to purchase the instrument if your child continues lessons next academic year).

Stage 1 lessons: 1 x 15-minute lessons weekly (beginners)

Stage 2 lessons: 1 x 20-minute lessons weekly (intermediate)

Stage 3 lessons: 2 x 15-minute lessons weekly (advanced)

Chess Club

Founded in 2015, we are a local chess club that is active in Kensington and Chelsea. We run school clubs as well as organising tournaments, holiday camps and weekly clubs. Over the years we have trained several children who have gone on to represent their country in international tournaments and many who have developed a deep appreciation for the game.

Chess can be beneficial in teaching important life skills such as: dealing with wins & losses, planning ahead, accountability for actions, analysing, reflecting and improving, learning to focus.

Cost per session: £10 for After School Club (Tuesday) & £7.50 for Lunch Time Clubs (Monday & Thursday). Fee paid in advance for the term.

Beginner club: For children new to chess. Children will learn how the pieces move and capture and then move onto concepts such as the difference between check and checkmate.

Intermediate/Advanced Club: For children that know how the pieces move and capture and can set up a basic checkmate. Children will learn how to use tactics (short term tricks) and strategies (long term plans) that will help them to win a game of chess.

There might be some movement from beginners' group to intermediate/advanced group at the start of the new term.

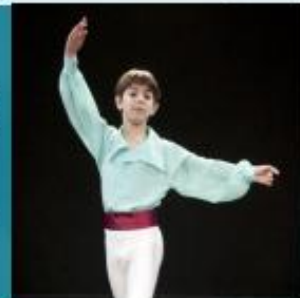
